From 1985 the activity of the Association “Il Pioppo” Onlus is mainly addressed to foster the social integration of persons in situation or at risk of exclusion and deviance: drug addicts, marginalised minors with criminal records, former offenders, prisoners. The usual activity of Il Pioppo Onlus includes services for recovering and treat drug addicts and decrease juvenile uneasiness and social exclusion, awareness actions in the schools to promote legality and prevent the use of drugs among students, initiatives to contrast the rackets and mafias activities, services of assistance for immigrants, initiatives inside the prisons in Naples to promote the reintegration in society of offenders and prevent recidivist crime behaviour. Il Pioppo Onlus has close relations of cooperation with the health and social departments of the Municipality of Naples and Campania Region. Among the recent successful projects we quote:
